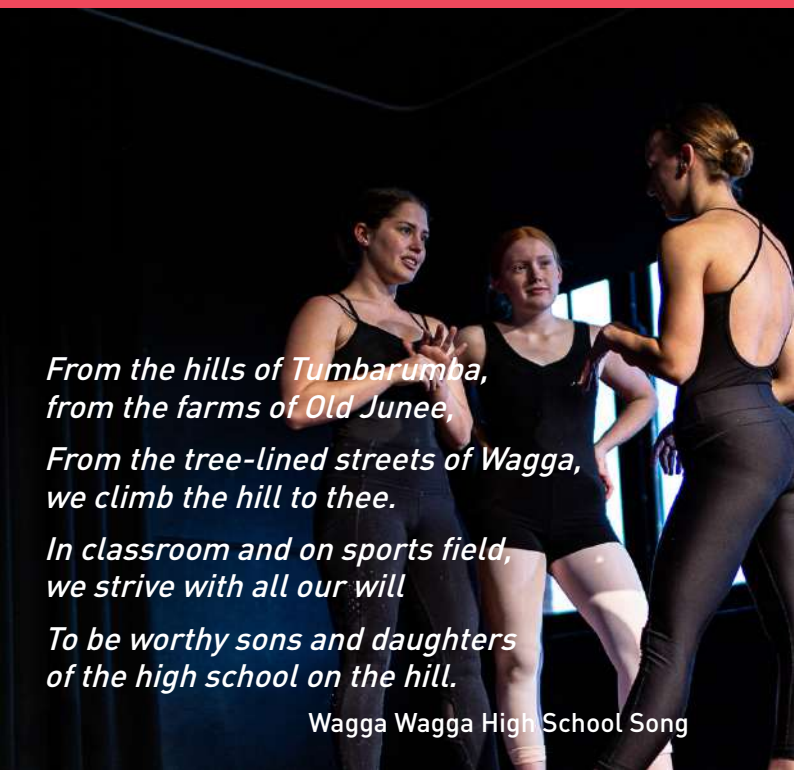
*From the hills of Tumbarumba,
